The fundraiser is the major source of revenue for ALL of the Hospital Auxiliary programs. Our mission for the golf event each year has been to deliver a memorable golf experience while raising money for a worthwhile cause.



We are grateful to the players, volunteers, committee members, host golf courses, sponsors and prize donors who help us each year to achieve this mission.

Last year we reached the \$1.0 million milestone of total support we have been able to provide within our community over the history of the tournament.

IMPACT OF THE HOSPITAL AUXILIARY

- The Hospital Auxiliary continues to expand its reach within the community and its positive impact.
- The Hospital Auxiliary has helped thousands of patients at Hilton Head Regional and Coastal Carolina Hospital and has supported over 200 nursing students obtain an education at USC Beaufort and Technical College of the Lowcountry.

ENTRY FEE

- The cost per player is going up slightly from last year due to cost increases we have incurred
- Cost for the team of 4 players is \$1600.
- Once again, we expect to be sold out so it is important that you adhere to the instructions and timelines.

TEAM REGISTRATION

- Opens July 1 and closes September 1.
- Team captains will register ALL four players in Golf Genius (ONLINE)

- GHIN number or equivalent and Tee box selection are required fields

PAYMENT

- Payment fork the entire team (\$1600) must be received by <u>September 15</u> to confirm your team spot.

- Player changes: Team captains will be able to make player changes in the online Golf Genius registration site up until a week before the event.

DAY OF EVENT

- We will have a shotgun start on both days of the event on November 27th and 28th.
 Wexford 9:30 am
 Harbour Town 10:00 am
- Team registration will open 1 hour before the shotgun on day one.
- Your team course rotation and starting hole will be provided as we get closer to the
- We will use Live scoring for the event and you will record the Gross score for each player.

When you arrive on the first day of the tournament you will receive:

- A sleeve of Wilson golf balls, compliments of John White from Wilson Sporting Goods.
- PGA Tour Superstore bag with discount certificates for merchandise, compliments of Bill Fuentes from the PGA Tour Superstore.
- Tournament booklet containing a variety of information including rules and format, and a special section featuring each of our sponsors, compliments of Lou Haley from Accurate Litho.

HANDICAP/TEES

Your course handicap will be based on your 11/22/23 index from the selected tee x 80%. Men's Tees: You may choose to play from the regular tees at 6,200 yards or the "Tee It Forward" tees at 5,800 yards. The default tees for male golfers will be 6,200. Ladies' Tees: You will play from the tees set at 5,100 yards.

- If a player chooses to "tee it forward," an adjustment will be made by the tournament software. Player must play from the same tees both days.
- On November 22, we will update the handicaps using GHIN numbers provided and finalize the flights based on the total team handicap.

FORMA1

Two (2) Best Balls (NET) of foursome over 36 holes. Your team has been placed in one of 18 flights based on the team's total HDCP.

RULES

- Winter Rules (Lift, clean and place--one club length--no closer to hole in your own fairway) ARE in effect. USGA plus local club rules apply. The club professional staff at each course will serve as official rules committee and their judgment is final. Electronic yardage aids ARE permitted. Anchoring is permitted. USGA rules will decide all ties. In the case of a tie, the Harbour Town score will be used as the tie breaker, then last 9, last 6, 3, 1 at Harbour Town.
- Flagstick: Under the Rules of Golf, players are permitted to leave the flagstick in the hole while putting.

SPEED OF PLAY

Please keep up with the group ahead of you. If you can't improve on your team score, pick it up.

LIVE SCORING

We are going to do live scoring again this year and hope for 100% participation. You can monitor how your team is doing during play and to speed up the process of determining the tournament results.

- One competitor must complete a hard copy scorecard that is the official scorecard.
 One competitor will enter GROSS scores for each player via the Golf Genius app. On your scorecard you will have a 6-digit number you will enter in the Golf Genius app.
- The group must turn in their scorecard and sign as official. We will verify the hard copy with their online postings and make any adjustments necessary before submitting scores.
- It is recommended that you designate the player who will do the live scoring and download the app in advance of the tournament. The pro staff will be available during Monday registration to help you get set up and to answer questions.

TOURNAMENT RESULTS

You will be able to see the tournament results each day through our web portal.

AWARDS BANQUET

We will continue the long standing tradition of the Awards' Banquet. It will begin after play on Tuesday at approximately 3 pm at the Harbour Town banquet room in the main clubhouse. There will be a cash bar, but each player receives one complimentary drink ticket.

TOURNAMENT TEAM PRIZES: Golf certificate for 4 players

- #1 Low Net Team will have their names engraved on the permanent Max Stein Award and have first choice of a complimentary round of golf.
- Golf prizes for Low Overall Gross and then 2nd-4th place Overall Net.
- First place in EACH of the 18 flights

FOOD & BEVERAGE

- Java Burrito will provide morning coffee and Kroger will provide donuts at Wexford.
 There will be coffee at Harbour Town.
- Kroger will provide lunch each day and Coca Cola will provide soft drinks and water.
 Beverage carts will be on the course for snacks/other beverages at your own expense.

ON COURSE INDIVIDUAL PRIZES

HOLE IN ONE: Hilton Head BMW will provide a 2-year lease valued at \$10,000 on a 2024 BMW for ANY hole-in-one scored on the 17th hole at Harbour Town and ANY hole-in-one on the 13th hole at Wexford. Various hole-in-one prizes will also be awarded on other par-3 holes at both courses. (Reminder: Pros are NOT eligible for ANY hole-in-one prize!)

NOTE: To be eligible to win the grand prize, men must play from a minimum of 165 yards and ladies from 150 yards. For all other hole-in-one bonus prizes the men can play from 130 yards and the ladies from 115 yards.

- CLOSEST TO THE PIN: One dozen Wilson golf balls will be awarded for closest-to-the
 -pin on all par 3's on both golf courses, each day of the event.
- PUTTING CONTEST: There will be a putting contest on both days at Harbour Town
 and Wexford. In addition, there is a set of Wilson irons for overall closest to PIN on
 #14 HT. There are \$500 Kroger gift cards for the winner and other excellent prizes
 for the runner-up each day AND a special prize for ladies donated by Heritage Fine
 Jewelry.
- You are asked to make a voluntary contribution of \$10 for one putt or \$20 for 3 putts each day which will go directly to the Wexford Foundation and the Sea Pines Junior Golf initiative

HISTORY OF THE TOURNAMENT

A primary source of revenue to fund the Hospital Auxiliary programs is our annual golf tournament. The tournament was started as an 18-hole tournament at Harbour Town in 1986 by Max **Stein.** Max expanded the event to 36 holes in 1988 and continued to chair it until he was 90 years old. He then passed leadership on to **Lew** Wessel who managed it for 10 years.



In 2017, Bob Elliott, a retired senior marketing executive from Dow Chemical and member at Belfair, took over the reins as Tournament Director. Through his tireless perseverance, creativity and dedication, Bob has made the tournament more successful each year. He and his committee run a tournament that continues to have a sellout field of 280 every year because it combines two days of outstanding golf at a great price and at the best courses with a spirited, fun atmosphere.

Our tournament has become known as the most prestigious charity golf event on the island. In recent years we have been able to double the proceeds with the support of loyal golfers and sponsors.



We have added new levels of sponsorship opportunities ranging from \$1,000 to \$5,000. We encourage our sponsors to play in the golf event and have offered complimentary player spots at the various sponsor levels in addition to the promotion and recognition we provide.

In 2022, the Committee reached its goal of achieving \$1.0 Million in total contributions to the Hospital Auxiliary from the golf tournament over its 36 years. One of the major areas of focus is to provide nursing scholarships to students in an effort to reduce the tremendous shortfall which exists in our local communities.

In 2022 we were able to extend our reach and support to the community by raising a record \$75,000 allocated as follows:

- \$15,000 for the Nursing and Allied Health Program at the Technical College of the Lowcountry,
- \$20,000 for the Nursing Program at USC Beaufort,
- \$25,000 in scholarships for qualified hospital volunteers and children of hospital employees to pursue degrees in the medical field, and
- \$15,000 for The Auxiliary Caring Touch Program (A.C.T.) and the Women's Health Program.

A.C.T. The Auxiliary Caring Touch Program provides financial assistance to qualified patients discharged from specific local medical facilities who are financially unable to pay for certain healthcare needs. The Auxiliary provides emergency help to pay for critically needed prescription medicines or special equipment for a limited period of time until other financial resources can be found.



The Women's Health initiative of The Hospital Auxiliary promotes and supports women's health issues through educational literature, informational programs and special needs and provides handbooks for newly diagnosed breast cancer patients at The Breast Health Center in Bluftton.

HOW DOES THE HOSPITAL AUXILIARY HELP THE COMMUNITY?

Over the past several years The Hospital Auxiliary has continued to expand its reach within the community and its impact. The Auxiliary:

- Supports a qualified volunteer staff to enhance the ongoing pursuit of
 excellence at our two hospitals, Hilton Head Hospital and Coastal Carolina
 Hospital, as well as the Bluffton-Okatie Outpatient Center, Bluffton Medical
 Campus, and the Tidewatch Emergency Department. Volunteers offer an extra
 dimension of care and service to patients, families and visitors and supportive
 services to medical staff.
- Provides scholarships for students entering the health care field
- Partners with the Children's Memorial Garden, a place created to honor and remember those sons and daughters who have passed.
- Operates the Auxiliary Gift Shops at both hospitals for the convenience of patients, visitors and staff.
- Furnishes transportation via "The Auxiliary Trolley" to drive patients and visitors to and from parking lots, physician offices and outpatient clinics (Hilton Head Hospital Campus).
- Promotes and supports women's health issues through educational literature, informational programs and special needs.
- Administers and funds the Auxiliary Caring Touch Program (A.C.T.) which assists patients without sufficient funds or insurance with their prescription medicines or special equipment needs.
- In addition, under A.C.T., infant car seats are provided to patients who do not have the financial ability or access to programs which provide protective carriers for newborns.
- Provides funding to help other community agencies (Boys & Girls Club, Bluffton Township Fire Department, Volunteers in Medicine).

In addition to the programs listed above, there are new initiatives the Auxiliary has embarked on for 2023-24:

- The Auxiliary increased and expanded its contributions for nursing student scholarships at USCB including their Rural Campus in Walterboro, SC.
- The Auxiliary will partner with TCL and USCB to encourage and support high school students wishing to enter the medical profession and work with local guidance counselors.
- In 2023, the Auxiliary provided a special scholarship program to support nursing students from Hilton Head Island.
- The Auxiliary committed funds for the retention of nurses in primary health care on Hilton Head Island.
