Letter from the President

Happy New Year volunteers and friends. 2024 was a very good year for the Hospital Auxiliary and I would like to thank all of you for your ongoing efforts to improve healthcare in the Low Country. We have a great bunch of folks with a lot of talent, and the Hospital appreciates all that you do!

There were lots of changes in 2024, the largest being the acquisition of Hilton Head Regional by Novant Healthcare, which is a not-for-profit healthcare corporation. During the year, Novant transitioned all of the accounting, business and HR systems from the old owners to the new. In addition, Novant announced that they would be investing hundreds of millions of dollars in our region, with the construction of a new 50-bed acute care hospital and associated facilities in Bluffton. Finally, Novant has posted the new full-time position of Volunteer Coordinator and is currently reviewing candidates. We all look forward to working with the new Volunteer Coordinator in 2025.

The Auxiliary's charitable giving was very active in 2024. We provided \$65,000 in grants to USCB and TCL, which was distributed to 36 students in need and \$25,000 in direct scholarships to 10 Novant employees or children of employees. We spruced up the Children's Memorial Garden at Hilton Head Hospital, and supported the annual ceremony in early May, which was attended by more than 100 people. During National Hospital Week, we handed out snacks to all the departments at both hospitals. We continue to provide trolley services on the Hilton Head campus, and to support Dr. Ringer and the Women's Breast Health Center by providing educational materials to patients. Also, the Auxiliary continues to support uninsured and underinsured patients via the ACT Program.

In the community, the Auxiliary has made a major investment in the SC Nurse Retention Initiative, as it directly contributes to reducing employment turnover and keeping nurses working in our two hospitals. We also introduced a new category of participation – Friends of the Auxiliary – for people that want to support the Auxiliary without doing volunteer work. Finally, we had a successful volunteer luncheon in September to acknowledge and thank all of our volunteers for their incredibly valuable contributions to healthcare in our community.

On the fundraising front, we had a very successful golf tournament in November. Over 280 players participated on two beautiful days and had lots of fun. We had more than 40 different sponsors who contributed cash and prizes to the cause. The tournament netted about \$95,000 that will go directly to charitable activities in 2025. Our two Gift Shops had the best year since Covid and netted about \$24,000 for us to distribute this year. In addition, we received donations from a variety of sources and were successful with several grant applications.

As we enter 2025, we anticipate working closely with Novant and expanding our reach in the healthcare community. I look forward to working with all of you!



Through the funds the Auxiliary received from a Power:Ed grant, we were able to distribute \$30,000 in scholarships to deserving nursing students at USCB and TCL. TCL recipients are pictured left. Power:Ed is a philanthropy of the South Carolina Student Loan Corporation. Over the past several years, Power:Ed has awarded almost \$4 million to support economically marginalized, minority and first-generation students to improve access to college and advanced degrees. This support helps create pathways to quality workforce opportunities for these disadvantaged students.
